**The story of Aeneas and Tabitha teach us that,**

**1. The Power of Christ \_\_\_\_\_.**

- **Both Aeneas and Tabitha heard the call, “Rise!”**

*We see that people need to experience the power of God, which changes  
lives forever.*

**2. The Power of Christ Should be Working \_\_\_\_\_ You; Not  
Your Own \_\_\_\_\_**

- **Peter is depending on the power of Jesus Christ to heal  
Aeneas and raise Tabitha.**

*We often say, “What can I do?” We must learn to say, “What can  
Christ do through me?”*

### **HEAD**

1. What does this passage teach us about God and His power?
2. What does this passage teach us about mankind through the experiences of Peter, Aeneaus, Tabitha, and the widows?

### **HEART**

1. How do you think Peter felt throughout this experience?
2. How might the experience of seeing Tabitha raised back to life have impacted the widows?
3. When you reflect on God's power and the impact of faith in this passage, how do you feel?

### **HANDS**

1. In the story, there were many action items taking place (get up, roll up your mat, turning to the Lord, the sending of others, urging, prayer, believing in the Lord). What action do you feel God is leading you to in your own life?
2. What goal can you set for this coming week that will help you take action in response to this passage?
